

Stevens Gould, City Resident 22 Years, Dies

Stevens Gould, 63, of 2135 Chamberlain ave., a Madison resident for 22 years, died in a Madison hospital Tuesday night (Aug. 8, 1961) after a brief illness.

Born in Oshkosh, Mr. Gould moved to Madison in 1939. He graduated from the University of Wisconsin with an engineering degree in 1922. At the university he was a member of the varsity football team, playing offensive halfback and defensive end under the late Coach John Richards.

Mr. Gould, who was retired, was a World War I Navy veteran and a member of Psi Upsilon fraternity.
